



Coronavirus information for visitors, suppliers and contractors

Overview:

Our priority is to safeguard the health and wellbeing of the people that work with, and for, Avara Foods. We have undertaken a thorough risk assessment of our business and implemented a number of mitigating measures. While protective measures may be relaxed in wider society, we will continue to take a cautious approach to maintain the safest possible environment. This means that many of the measures that have been so effective to date will likely remain in place longer than in wider society.

Precautionary measures

Below are some headline measures, which you will be expected to follow once on site. You should speak with your site contact to understand the specific requirements and site controls before you arrive.

- Handwashing and hygiene
 - Handwashing and personal hygiene are vital to help prevent the spread of coronavirus. While on site you must wash your hands regularly and thoroughly, for a least 20 seconds, or use hand sanitiser where handwashing facilities are not available.
- Face covering
 - We expect everyone to wear a face covering when on site, and anyone arriving without a face covering will not be permitted access to the site.
- Social distancing
 - At each of our sites various social distancing measures are in place and must be observed: from markings specifying minimum distances to screens that separate individuals. Social distancing protocols must be observed at all times.
- Temperature checking
 - All site visitors will be temperature checked before they are admitted to the site. You will only be allowed on site if you agree to have your temperature checked and it is verified that you do not have a fever.
- Chaperones
 - Given the critical importance of the protocols we have put in place you should expect to be accompanied during your time on site. This is to ensure that you are fully aware of, and comply with, the relevant requirements specific to your work on site.
- COVID-19 testing
 - We ask everyone attending an Avara site, including employees, to take a Lateral Flow test no more than 72 prior to arrival, and to only make the journey if the result is negative.

Each site has implemented our protocols in a way that matches their individual situation and you should speak with your site contact prior to travel to ensure that you can prepare accordingly.

Most importantly, we have made clear to everyone at Avara that they should only come to work if they are healthy and symptom-free. The same applies to visitors and contractors. If you, or anyone in your household, has had any COVID-19 symptoms within the last seven days you must not travel to our site and you will not be granted access.
